How to Submit Your Article?

What to Include

- Complete manuscript in Word (.docx) or PDF format
- Abstract (200-250 words)
- Author bio (100-150 words) with current position and affiliation
- Professional headshot (minimum 300 DPI)
- 5-7 keywords for indexing
- Supporting visuals (graphs, charts, photos—optional but encouraged)

Editorial Standards

- Citations: APA 7th Edition style
- Tone: Academic yet accessible—write for educated non-specialists
- Evidence: All factual claims must be supported by credible sources
- Originality: Original work not previously published or under consideration elsewhere

Review Process

- Initial review: Within 7 business days
- Peer review: 2-3 weeks for selected articles
- Revision period: 10-14 days
- Publication: Accepted articles published in next quarterly issue
